The ONA's mandate is to advance, assert, support and preserve Okanagan Nation sovereignty. This Okanagan Nation Natural Resources Committee (NRC) mandate is facilitated through the Natural Resource Land Use Team (NRLUT). NRLUT focuses on all major natural resource issues to address impacts, benefits, and management concerns, while re-enforcing the Okanagan Nation's collective interests held in common on the traditional territory and related waterways.
