Position postings for Gladue Coordinators – Contract positions

The BC First Nations Justice Council (BCFNJC) is a young organization with an ambitious mandate to transform BC's criminal justice and child protection systems for Indigenous people. The organization is headquartered in Westbank, BC and provincial in scope, and currently building capacity required to deliver on the recently signed BC First Nations Justice Strategy.

We are hiring for two full-time contract positions to support the implementation of our new Gladue Services program. These roles will be based from our head office in Westbank, BC. Remote work from home will be balanced with team work in the office.

We are looking for energetic, enthusiastic people to help us with change management activities with multiple stakeholder groups in the justice system. This will include participating in working groups comprised of a number of provincial ministries as well as our own staff.

Contract 1 – Communications focus

Working with our Communications team, this role will support the Gladue working group to design, promote and execute their communications plan to the Judiciary, Crown prosecutors, defense counsel, and First Nations people throughout the province. This will include developing and delivering webinars, social media activities, print materials and speaking materials for team members.

Contract 2 – Technology focus

Working with the Gladue Services team, this role will focus on ensuring the multiple technology platforms and providers work together seamlessly to achieve our collective goals. This will include analysis of the website, databases and interactive platform for confidential legal documents and ensuring that there are appropriate security protocols in place to keep the information safe. Liaising with our staff, the service providers and the technology specialists within the Ministry of Justice and Ministry of Public Safety will be important parts of this work.
