A film by the Wild Sheep Society of BC. The Wild Sheep Society of BC is one of BC's leading conservation organizations. One of their action items is to continue the study of a pandemic happening amongst wild sheep.

The infectious bacteria known as mycoplasma ovipneumoniae (movi) is a bacteria that is passed from domestic sheep to wild sheep. Wild sheep do not have the immune systems to fight the bacteria, thus leaving them susceptible to pneumonia which, in most cases, leads to death.

yilik^wlxkn - Bighorn Sheep in the southern Okanagan have steadily declined in recent years. There are ongoing health issues affecting California bighorn sheep in the Okanagan Valley known as Psoroptic ("sore-op-tic") Mange and Mycoplasma ovipneumoniae (M. ovi).
